Title of the programme: Scandinavian Master Studies

Education level and qualification received by those who have successfully completed the MA program:

- Education level: master degree (magister, master; abbreviation: MA), MA in Scandinavian Languages and Literatures

Duration: 4 terms

Credits required for graduation: 120 credits

At the beginning of their studies students may choose their main Scandinavian language (Danish, Norwegian or Swedish) and one of two modules (philological or cultural). Besides taking courses common for both modules and all main languages, courses specific to one of the main languages and either of the modules give more specific knowledge and skills: both modules offer education in the main fields of philology (language, literature, linguistics and culture) but in the Cultural module some aspects of cultural transfer between Scandinavia and Hungary are emphasized.
