- (2) a 200-word **summary** of your poster presentation;
- (3) your name and e-mail address;
- (4) topic area (English and American literature, English and American history, English speaking cultures, Theoretical linguistics, Applied linguistics, Language pedagogy (including ELT); and
- (5) **level** (BA, MA, or PhD).
- (6) BA and MA students should also include the **name of an instructor** at their respective institutions who has agreed to support their application. (PhD students need not ask for a reference.)
