### Explanation of Prerequisites

A prerequisite with no equals (=) sign or parenthesis (e.g. XKO16-106): ‘strong’ prerequisite; must be completed successfully at least one semester before the course unit in question for which it is listed as a prerequisite.

A prerequisite with an equals (=) sign before it (e.g. =MNY11-264): must be completed in the same semester as the course for which it is listed as a prerequisite, but must be completed successfully for the course for which it is a prerequisite to be valid (if the prerequisite course is failed, the course for which it is a prerequisite will be invalid).

A prerequisite with a parenthesis [e.g. (MNY11-243)]: ‘soft’ prerequisite; should be completed before the course unit for which it is listed as a prerequisite, but can be completed in the same semester also. It must also be completed successfully for the course for which it is a prerequisite to be valid (if the prerequisite course is failed, the course for which it is a prerequisite will be invalid).
