

SEMINARS

- practical classes take place in small-sized groups of 10-15 students.
- Attendance is obligatory and checked. A seminar means continuous assessment throughout the semester (this involves a mid term and an end term test, handing in homework assignments on a regular basis, or meeting any other requirements specified in the course syllabus).
- The grade awarded for a seminar will be a reflection of the quality and quantity of your work throughout the semester, so a seminar does not usually involve an exam.
- This is why your grade will usually become available at the very end of the study period or the very beginning of the exam period.



LEGTURES

- Attendance is generally not checked.
- If your instructor makes attendance obligatory, it will be checked.
- There is generally no continuous assessment of your work throughout the semester, so you will have to take an exam in the exam period.
- There are NO exams in the study period.




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
