





Passive semesters

- Only 2 consecutive (semesters after each other) passive semesters.
- 3rd is with permission.



36 credits

Please be sure that you complete minimum 36 credits during the first 3 semesters of your studies.

"The student shall be expelled from the programme if he/she fails to obtain 36 credits over the course of his/her first three active semesters."

(Academic Regulations for Students, Section 327)



Credit exceeding

- When you take more credits than it is necessary for your study programme, you need to pay.
- Over 110% of necessary credits.
- Not completed credits are also counted in the exceeding!*

*except for the case when you take the course again, and pay for it



Number of course and exam registrations

3 COURSE REGISTRATIONS + EXAM TRIES 6 TIMES ONLY

- If you do not complete a course after 3 course registrations and/or 6 exam tries your student status will be terminated = cancelled automatically.
- In the case of language proficiency exams, 4 registrations are allowed.

If you are not sure about your knowledge/success of the exam, drop the exam 24 hours before the exam date!



Educational committee

- Chairperson: Vice-Dean for Educational Affairs
- Members: Teachers and students from the Students' Union of the Faculty
- 2-3 meetings/semester (beginning and end of semester)
- Decision on students' study issues.

For what issues do I need to hand in a request to the committee?

- Weakening of prerequisites.
- 4th or more course registration of one subject.
- 7th or more exam registration of a subject.
- 3rd or more consecutive passive semesters.
- Late request for a passive semester (only with a doctor's certificate).



Credit transfer committee

- One meeting/semester (at the beginning of the semester).
- Chairperson & members: teachers and students from the Students' Union of the Faculty

For what issues do I need to hand in a request to the committee?

If you have some completed courses from other programmes/specialisations, and you would like to have their credits accepted within your current programme.



Offical requests

Requests related to your studies must be submitted

- either in Neptun (e-forms)
- or at the Office of Educational Affairs.

With the "TAJ card" (the card for Hungary's national health insurance scheme), scholarship holders are publicly ensured and they are able to access public healthcare for free at the health care institutions in their district, not just emergency or urgent care



What is TAJ Card?

Those are also entitled to have the TAJ card who have

- ✓a foreign citizenship
- ✓ no permanent accommodation in Hungary

BUT

✓ have a temporary Hungarian accommodation

AND

✓ Stipendium Hungaricum/Diaspora scholarship



How to get your TAJ card?



- ✓ Request for TAJ card: https://qter.elte.hu/Ugy.aspx/HealthInsuranceCardRequest
- ✓The needed documents can be found at the Quaestura Office's website:
 - ✓ TAJ-card request sheet please fill the Request sheet beforehand
 - ✓ <u>Authorization document</u>, in which you authorize Quaestura Office to request and to receive your card. Please, ask two witnesses, who will also sign the document.
 - ✓ Letter of Acceptance
 - ✓ Passport pages that include your personal data.
 - ✓ **Residence permit** both sides
 - ✓ Accommodation reporting form both sides, only after the <u>Regional Directorate of the National Directorate-General for Aliens Policing</u> has validated it.

How to get your tax card?



- ✓ You need to request a Tax Card in person at the <u>National Tax and Customs</u> <u>Administration</u> (Nemzeti Adó- és Vámhivatal). Nearest office: 1097 Budapest, Vaskapu u. 33.
- ✓ First application for a Tax Card is free of charge.
- ✓ You are required to take with you **your passport**.
- ✓ Tax card is must, in order to receive scholarship!



Bank account



- passport
- valid residence permit
- address card (validated accommodation reporting form)
- o some banks allow foreigners to open an account with just the presentation of a passport ©
- o in Hungary banks are typically open on weekdays from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Banks are not open on Saturdays except some branches in shopping centers.
- ATM machines are widely available in major cities, and they accept Visa and MasterCard.
