# Border crossing, entry information

- With a valid residence permit or type-D visa, no equity request is necessary.
- Equity request necessary:
  - **EU countries:** without EU immunity certificate
  - **Non-EU countries:** without valid residence permit or type-D visa





# Border crossing, entry information

## Quarantine:

NO: with an immunity certificate accepted by Hungary

YES: without an immunity certificate or with a certificate not accepted by Hungary

- Schedule your arrival and quarantine (if necessary) before the start of the semester.

# COVID regulations in Hungary

- Always check the university pages for update





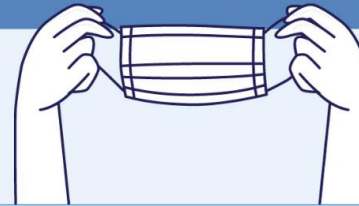
# WE ARE HAPPY TO SEE YOU AT THE UNIVERSITY

Practice good hand hygiene by washing your hands with soap and water or using alcohol or hand sanitizer.



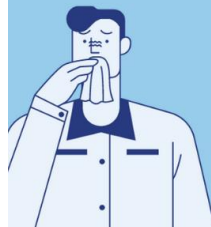
## PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING
