RESIDENCE PERMIT

WITH D-TYPE VISA

- Permit issued automatically
- 3-4 weeks
- Receive at the university OR
- Receive it at the office of the National Directorate-General for Aliens Policing (Immigration Office)

- Submit a request for the permit within 90 days after arrival

KEEPING YOUR STAY LEGAL

- Clarify student status (active or passive)
- Keep us informed at all times about changes
- Do not be active while staying away from school for any reason
- Report all emergencies affecting your status
- Request information from us if you have any doubts or questions



KEEPING YOUR STAY LEGAL

- If you do not take classes, and your semester is Active, you need to pay tuition fee or it is counted among the semesters of the scholarship.
- In case of a Passive semester, you cannot stay in the country with your study permit.

STUDENT CARD

ELTE Student ID

Can be used for identification

Discount at Hungarian transportation

Discount at some shops, services, cinema, festivals, museums, etc.

STUDENT CARD – STUDENTS STAYING SHORTER THAN 12 MONTHS

Temporary Student ID paper

Issued by Quaestura Student Office

Available around the 3rd week of September

Until then, buy a full-price transportation pass

Budapest Transport Service (BKK) exchanges it for a student pass when you have the Student ID paper.

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STUDENT CARD – STUDENTS STAYING LONGER THAN 12 MONTHS

Student ID (plastic card)

Student needs to start the process.

Takes 1-2 months until ready.

Until then, use a temporary student ID (see previous slide).

Temporary student ID is given only after you started the process for the card.

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STUDENT CARD – STUDENTS STAYING LONGER THAN 12 MONTHS

Student ID (plastic card) steps:

Get a NEK number at Kormányablak (govt. office).


Start the card process in Neptun.

Go to Quaestura for a temporary ID until the card is ready.

Bring the originals and photocopies as well!

- Letter of Acceptance received from ELTE
- passport
- your original certificate of matriculation (graduation certificate from high school studies)
- If you will be an MA student: your BA degree certificate
- your Hungarian address (zip code, city, name of the street, floor, apartment number)
- your mobile phone number in Hungary
- student visa page
- 2 passport photos (colour) Write your full name at the back with capital letters
- Confirmation of Payment about having paid your tuition fee
- Your language certificate
- Enrolment sheet printed and signed from Neptun study system



DOCUMENTS FOR THE REGISTRATION (PART-TIME STUDENTS)

Bring the originals and photocopies as well!

- passport
- student visa page in passport
- accommodation reporting form (or some kind of document that shows your current address in Hungary: zip code, city, name of the public place, floor, door number)
- a printed ID photo of yourself (3.5 x 4.5 cm approximately. Write your full name at the back with capital letters!)
- Student status certificate from your sending university
- Language certificate (Hungarian studies only)


ENROLMENT (full-time students only)

After registration at the Dept. of International Affairs, you go to the Office of Educational Affairs

Coordinator:

Ms Emese KERTÉSZ – self-paying students + guest students

The Student Status Certificate can be issued after the registration. (necessary for the Residence Permit)









CREDITS

Bachelor programmes: 180 credits

Master programmes: 60* or 120 credits

*Instructor of English as a Foreign Language programme only

MINORS OR SPECIALIZATIONS - BA PROGRAMMES

The 180 credits of Bachelor studies contain a 50-credit module of a specialisation or a minor.

MINORS OR SPECIALIZATIONS – BA PROGRAMMES

Every study programme contains one or more compulsory 50-credit specialisation modules, which can be found in the curricula (study unit lists) of the study programmes.

SPECIALIZATIONS – ENGLISH AND AMERICAN STUDIES

When to start and when to choose the specialisation?

- Start from the 2nd year of studies.
- BUT! Specialisations should be chosen a semester in advance (in May-June) in Neptun.
- Can be started only after a successful language proficiency exam (normally taken at the end of the 1st year).

MINOR PROGRAMMES (BA)

- Instead of a specialization, choose a minor.
- 50-credit module different from one's study programme.
- → A 50-credit package of another study programme.
- Advantage: students can apply for a Master programme connected to the minor

MINOR PROGRAMMES (BA)

When to start and when to choose the specialisation?

- Some of the minors can be started from the 2nd year of studies.
- Most of the minor programmes should be started already in 1st semester, so they are 6-semester-long programmes, such as the BA.

The minor should be chosen in Neptun (May-June). The departments of studies examine all applications from Neptun, and they decide who can take/continue the minor programme next semester and further.

MINOR PROGRAMMES (BA)

Always check the curriculum, and contact your coordinator at the Department of International Affairs for consultation if you wish to choose a minor.

DEADLINE

Last day, date until you can do something. You can do it earlier either, before the deadline, but not later.



COURSE REGISTRATION (part-time)

In Neptun study system.

Based on the list from your department of studies.

Your coordinator and department helps.

Wait until your department contacts you.



COURSE REGISTRATION (full-time)

In Neptun study system.

Based on the curricula.

Watch the *Neptun tutorial* film.

Register for the courses as soon as possible.



COURSE REGISTRATION (full-time)

Be aware of the 3 registration periods.

Check your courses until the registration ends.

You can ask the help of your student mentor.

We can help you during the Neptun Training.

ALWAYS CHECK THE PREREQUISITES

Strong prerequisite:

e.g. BBI-ANG-102E

The prerequisite have to be completed previously.

Weak prerequisite:

e.g. (BBI-ANG-106E)

The prerequisite can be completed together with the particular course.





ACADEMIC REGULATIONS

Please check the university's Academic Regulations.

Passive semesters

- Only 2 consecutive (semesters after each other) passive semesters.
- 3rd is with permission.

36 credits

 Please be sure that you complete minimum 36 credits during the first 3 semesters of your studies.

"The student shall be expelled from the programme if he/she fails to obtain 36 credits over the course of his/her first three active semesters."

(Academic Regulations for Students, Section 327)



Credit exceeding

- When you take more credits than it is necessary for your study programme, you need to pay.
- Over 110% of necessary credits.
- Not completed credits are also counted in the exceeding!*

*except for the case when you take the course again, and pay for it



Credit exceeding

Example:

Your study programme is 180 credits, and you take 210 credits during your studies.

110% = 198 credits

210-198= 12 credits for which you pay before graduation

Number of course & exam registrations

3 COURSE REGISTRATIONS + EXAM TRIES 6 TIMES ONLY

- If you do not complete a course after 3 course registrations and/or 6 exam tries your student status will be terminated=cancelled automatically.
- In the case of language proficiency exams, 4 registrations are allowed.

If you are not sure about your knowledge/success of the exam, drop the exam 24 hours before the exam date!

Number of course & exam registrations

The termination can be avoided by handing in a request to the Educational Committee. For the 4th or further registration, or 7th or further exam attempts requests should be handed in after all semesters!

EDUCATIONAL COMMITTEE

- Chairperson: Vice-Dean for Educational Affairs
- Members: Teachers and students from the Students' Union of the Faculty
- 2-3 meetings/semester (beginning and end of semester)
- Decision on students' study issues.

EDUCATIONAL COMMITTEE

For what issues do I need to hand in a request to the committee?

- Weakening of prerequisites.
- 4th or more course registration of one subject.
- 7th or more exam registration of a subject.
- 3rd or more consecutive passive semesters.
- Late request for a passive semester (only with a doctor's certificate).

CREDIT TRANSFER COMMITTEE

- One meeting/semester (at the beginning of the semester).
- Chairperson & members: teachers and students from the Students' Union of the Faculty

CREDIT TRANSFER COMMITTEE

For what issues do I need to hand in a request to the committee?

If you have some completed courses from other programmes/specialisations, and you would like to have their credits accepted within your current programme.



OFFICIAL REQUESTS

Requests related to your studies must be submitted

- either in Neptun (e-forms)
- or at the Office of Educational Affairs.

English and German language library: main building






